

Primary protection goals

1. Enabling the distancing rules prevailing at the time
2. Traceability of contacts
3. Feasibility of the hygiene concept, especially admission regulations

What applies to **EXHIBITORS?** (As of 01/2022)

General

- In general, the current SARS-CoV-2 occupational health and safety ordinance of the federal government applies

Assembly and dismantling

- The hygiene concept for trade fairs applies outside the stand area (e.g. obligation to wear an FFP2 mask, in deviation from the Occupational Health and Safety Ordinance)

During the fair

- Instructing staff in hand hygiene and individual hygiene standards
- You are also responsible for health protection during customer meetings
- For catering stands, the current hygiene concept for the Bavarian catering industry applies

Admission regulations :

- Admission for staff only if 2G+ (vaccinated or recovered plus rapid test*) is fulfilled.
*Not applicable for persons who are considered boosted according to the current regulation.
- Keeping of staff lists, updated daily, at exhibition stands
- Personalised permanent passes for exhibitors

Compulsory mask-wearing:

- The wearing of an FFP2 mask indoors is mandatory, this does not apply at tables
- In outdoor areas / open-air grounds: obligation to wear an FFP2 mask if the minimum distance cannot be maintained.
- In cashier, counter and meeting areas, the obligation to wear a mask does not apply if employees are reliably protected by transparent partitions (see occupational health and safety).
 → Transparent partitions may be ordered via our Online Service Centre / homepage.

This applies to our and your **VISITORS** (As of 01/2022)

- Visitors will only be admitted to the fair if proof of 2G+ is provided.
 → Visitors will be provided with comprehensive information in advance, testing stations will be available close by.
 - FFP2 masks are mandatory indoors, exceptions identical to exhibitors
 - In outdoor areas / open-air grounds: obligation to wear an FFP2 mask if the minimum distance cannot be maintained.
